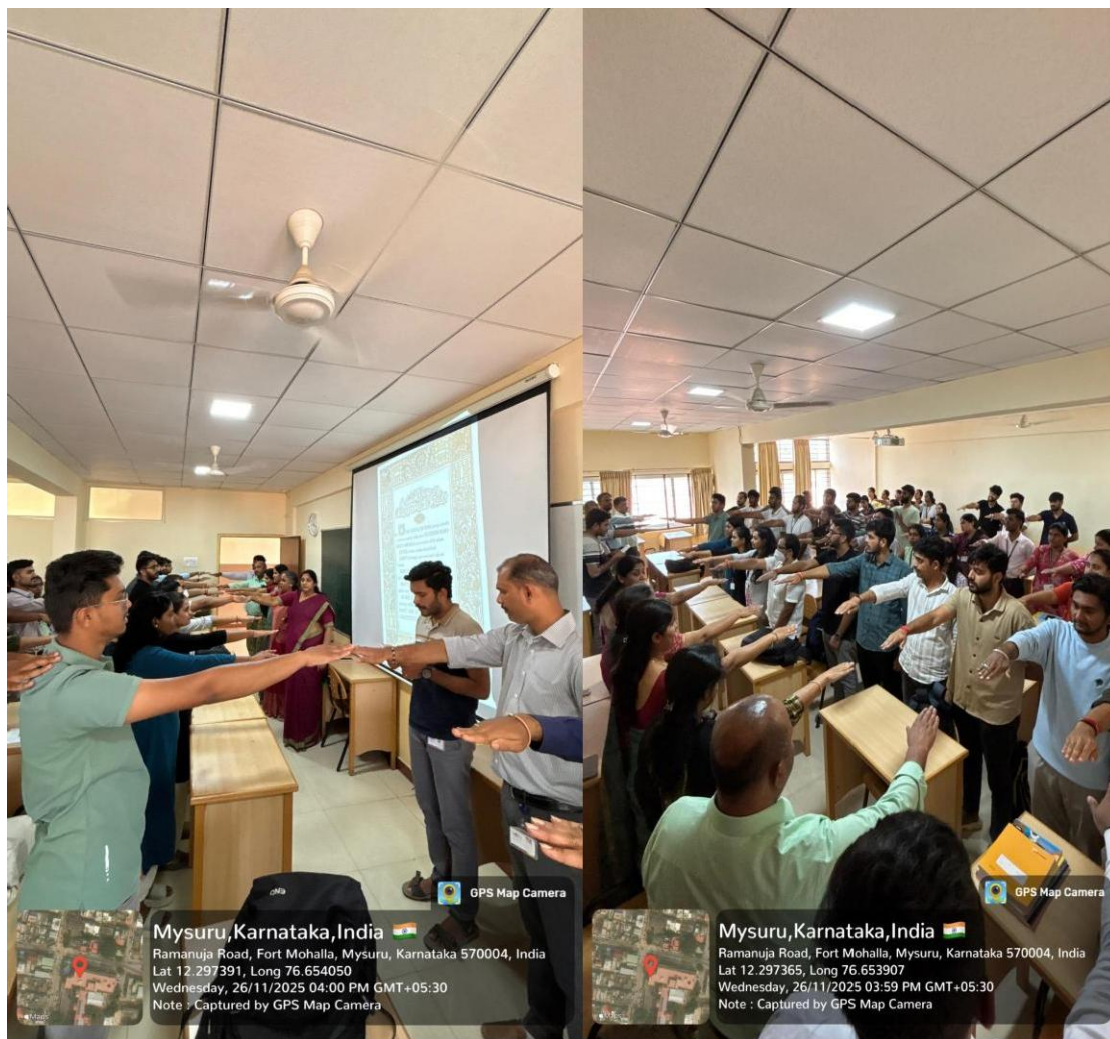
26/11 Martyrs' Day – Remembering the Heroes
