

NSS Annual Camp Report (2026).

The NSS Annual Camp was organized by the NSS unit of JSS Academy of Higher Education and Research, Mysore in the village called Koodanahalli located near the Nanjangudu road, Mysuru taluk. The camp was organized for seven days from 24th March 2026 to 30th March 2026.

Day 01 – Inauguration of the camp

Date: 24-03-2026



The NSS Annual Camp began on 24th March 2026. At around 2:00 PM, all volunteers departed from the college by bus to the camp site at Koodandahalli. Upon arrival, the volunteers cleaned the surroundings and arranged the venue for upcoming activities.

An inauguration ceremony was conducted in the presence of chief guests including

Day 02 – Survey and cleaning

Date: 25-03-2026

On the second day. At around 7:00 AM, all volunteers departed from the college by bus and reached to the camp site at Kodandahalli at 7:45 AM, the team assembled at 9:00 AM and assembly was conducted by team Kaveri and then the volunteers proceeded to the village for survey work.



The volunteers were divided into teams and conducted surveys to understand the lifestyle, problems, and needs of the local residents. The villagers were cooperative and shared valuable information. This helped the volunteers gain

awareness about rural living conditions and social issues.





Later, volunteers participated in a cleanliness drive, removing waste and improving hygiene in the area. And then we visited a nearby Mahadeshwara temple. After the activities, the team returned to the camp site, had snacks, and concluded the day. We left the camp site at 7:00PM and reached the college campus at 7:45PM.

Day 03 –Health camp and awareness about Tuberculosis.

Date: 26-03-2026



On day 3, at around 7:00 AM, all volunteers departed from the college by bus and reached to the camp site at Kodandahalli at 7:45 AM. An assembly was conducted by team Ganga. The Health camp was conducted from 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM which included general checkup of Blood pressure and diabetes, nutritional analysis, Ayurveda and awareness about microbial food spoilage. Many experts like Dr Pallavi N ,Dr Ashwini P,Dr Sumana K, Dr Swetha provided consultation to the villagers.



During post lunch activities Dr Umamaheshwari mam from JSS Academy of Higher Education and Research gave a talk on Tuberculosis and created awareness among the volunteers. Later snacks were provided and the cultural programme was held and we departed from the temple premises at 7:15PM and reached the college campus at 8:00 PM



The session was interactive and informative, helping students understand their responsibility toward the environment. The day ended with snacks and group photos.

Day 04 – Dental camp and cultural events.

Date: 27-03-2026



On day 4, at around 7:00 AM, all volunteers departed from the college by bus and reached to the camp site at Kodandahalli at 7:45 AM. The day began with assembly which was conducted by team Narmada. Day 05 –Sharamadhana
