MANGALORE**

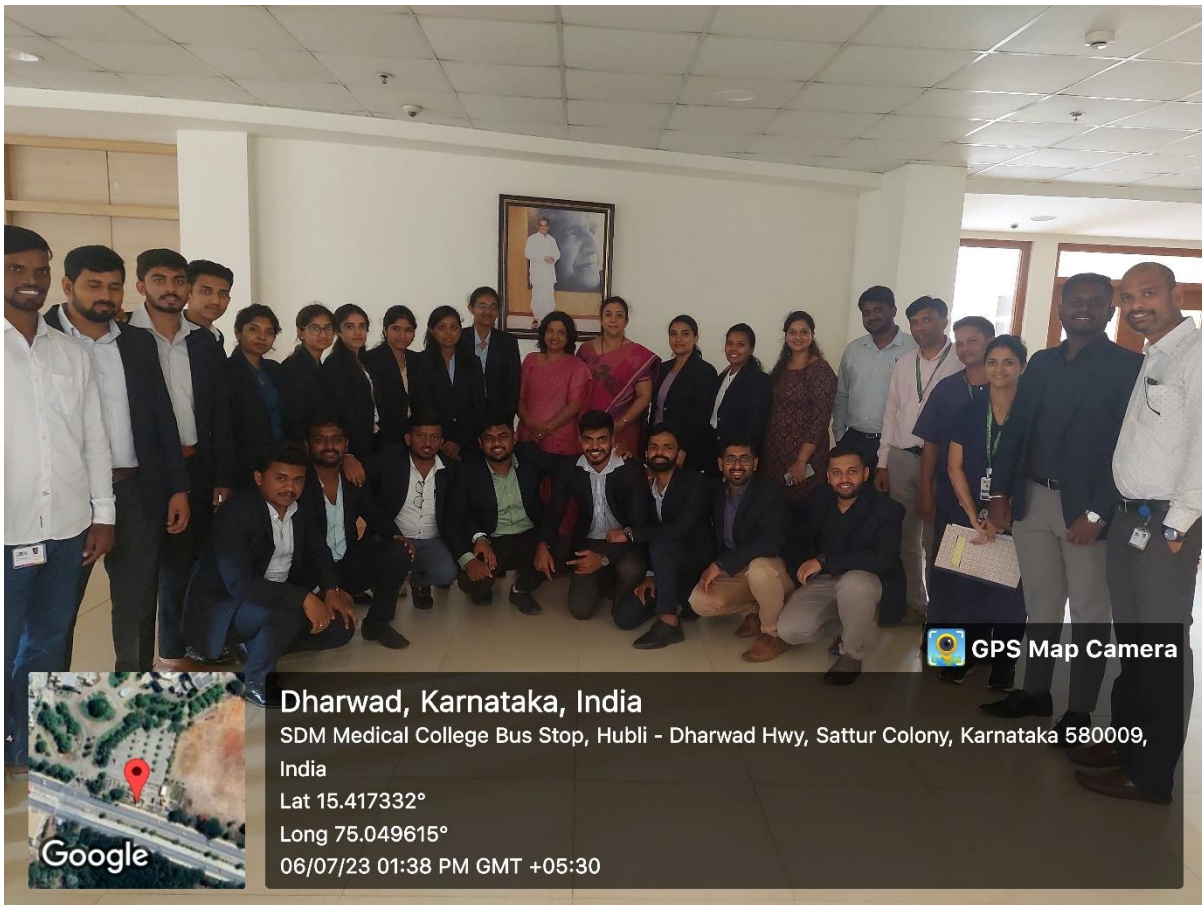
**6<sup>th</sup> July 2023 and 8<sup>th</sup> July 2023**

Students were divided into 2 groups and visited the various areas of the hospital like General OPD, Burns ICU,NICU, Milk Bank ,Radiology Department ,Emergency Department, wards (general and special wards),CSSD, MRD, Laundry.
