This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("MOU") is executed on this 18th November 2022 by and between:

1. KMF Hospital, Kotagiri - is a 50-bedded, charitable Christian mission hospital in the town of Kotagiri that was established in the year 1941 to provide healthcare of the highest quality to the people of the Nilgiris, located in the hilly Nilgiris district of Tamilnadu, India at Mission Compound, Kotagiri - 643217 The Nilgiris, Tamilnadu. India

(hereinafter referred to as "KMF Hospital"),

2. JSS College of Pharmacy, Ooty - a constituent college of JSS Academy of Higher Education & Research, Mysuru and having its principal office at Rocklands, Ooty

(hereinafter referred to as "JSSCPO").

KMF Hospital and JSSCPO may hereinafter collectively be referred to as the "Parties" and individually each of them may be referred to as a "Party".

# This MOU focuses on the following areas:

- 1. Student in-plant training and internship and clerkship in various departments
- 2. Students project course work for duration of 6 months to a maximum of 4 years
- Interaction between students and staffs with hospital personnel through guest lectures, conferences and symposium
- 4. Students placement based on the availability.

# Now the Memorandum of undertaking witnessth as follows;

The party having desire of providing

- (a) Co-operation and joint training of

  Pharm D students of JSSCPO at the premises of the FIRST PART by the Physicians / Clinicians / Pharmacists. This training shall include clinical pharmacy /hospital pharmacy activities at various specialty clinical settings viz., Internal Medicine, Family Medicine, Child Health and Neonatology, Neurosurgery/Neurology, Accident and Emergency, Trauma, Orthopaedic, Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Palliative Care etc. depending on the request from SECOND PART and feasibility to accommodate by FIRST PART and
- (b) The parties agree that this co-operation for placement is a recommendation but not an obligation
- (c) Co-operation and joint academic research (dissertation / thesis either in part or as a whole) leading to the award of Post Graduate degree / PhD degree as per the rules and regulations of the JSS AHER, Mysuru and other research activities as may be mutually agreed upon in writing between the PARTIES from time to time.

# RELATIONSHIP OF PARTIES

The Parties shall act in their independent capacities in the performance of their respective functions under this MOU and no Party shall be considered as an officer, agent or employee of the other Party.

#### TERM AND TERMINATION

• Each of the Definitive Agreements shall be in effect initially for a period of five years (18th November 2022 to 31st October 2027), from the date of its execution and may be renewed subject to mutual written agreement of the Parties. Either Party may terminate a Definitive Agreement by written notification thereof to the other Party at least 3 (three) months prior to the effective termination.

- The students shall be bound by the rules and regulations of KMF Hospital during their visits to KMF premises. KMF reserves the right to evict or restrict entry of any person who does not follow the rules and regulations of KMF Hospital.
- Any dispute pertaining to this MoU will be settled with due discussions between the MS of KMF Hospital, Kotagiri and the Principal of JSS College of Pharmacy, Ooty.
