

CSIR-HRD International Travel Grant Awarded to Dr. Ramith Ramu

Dr. Ramith Ramu, Assistant Professor, Department of Biotechnology & Bioinformatics, School of Life Sciences, JSS AHER has been awarded the prestigious “Partial Financial Assistance (PFA) Scheme for Indian regular employees (non-CSIR) for participation in international scientific events abroad” by Council of Scientific and Industrial Research - Human Resource Development (CSIR-HRD) Group.

This scheme is aimed at providing financial assistance to Young Indian Researchers (Ph.D. Students, Research Associates, resident Doctors, etc.), Emeritus Scientists, and other non-regular researchers for participation, presenting their research papers in international scientific Events such as conferences, seminars, symposia, workshops, short-term school, courses, training programs. The scheme provides up to full reimbursement of the actual airfare from the airport (nearest to the place of work in India) to the venue of the Event and back.

The travel grant was awarded to Dr. Ramith Ramu for participating in the “3rd Food Chemistry Conference: Shaping a healthy and sustainable food chain through knowledge (ELSEVIER)” arranged in Dresden, Germany from 10th October 2023 to 12th October 2023. At the conference, he presented his accepted poster designed on the topic “Multiprotein inhibitory effect of polyphenols from the whole green jackfruit targeting multiple stages of diabetes mellitus using in vitro and in silico approaches”.
