He played some motivational videos to enhance the thinking knowledge of the students. His motivational speeches do exactly that—it motivates. It engages the minds and hearts of people in such a way that motivates them to think more clearly, see opportunities, and move forward with action.



October 10, 2023

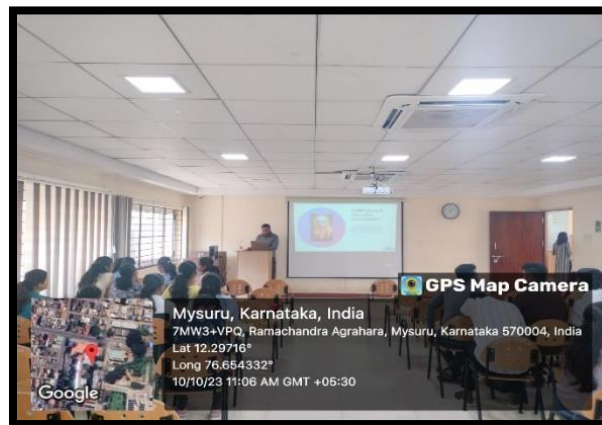
