

## REPORT OF THE VISIT TO YENAPOYA HOSPITAL, MANGALORE

20<sup>th</sup> June 2024

### DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SYSTEM MANAGEMENT STUDIES

The Department of Health System Management Studies organized a visit for the VI semester BBA students to Yenapoya Medical College and Hospital, Mangalore, to enhance their knowledge about the different types of hospitals and understand their functioning.

The visit was scheduled on 20<sup>th</sup> June 2024, taking prior permission from the hospitals and the University Authorities.



The visit was scheduled on the 20<sup>th</sup> of June 2024 from 10 am to 2 pm. 34 students from the final semester BBA, accompanied by three faculty Dr Divya, Mr Chethan Kumar and Mr Mahadevswamy visited the hospital. The operations team led by Mr Sabith interacted with the students and explained the hospital and the facilities to them. Students were divided into 2 groups and visited the various

areas of the hospital like OPD, Wards (general and special wards), Radiology, Central Laundry, Central Kitchen, CSSD, and OPD Front Office.

The faculty interacted with the operations team lead by Mr. Sabith and other members of the hospital.

The department welcomed the idea of students doing internships during vacation, and short time projects that would benefit the hospital. The visit helped the students not only in enhancing their knowledge and providing opportunity for learning but also provided scope for furthering the activities in terms of internship and project work.
